What is Information, Linkages and Capacity Building?

Information, Linkages and Capacity Building (ILC) are services that help you:



- find help in your local community



- take part in your local community like:

- learning new things



- playing sport



- going to social events



- do more and develop new skills



- get information.



ILC services will also help you get ready for the National Disability Insurance Scheme.

This is also called the NDIS.



The NDIS gives people with disability more choice and control over the supports they receive.

Who can use ILC supports?



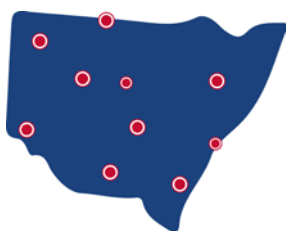
Everyone with a disability, their families and carers can access ILC services.

This also includes people who won't have an NDIS support package.

How can ILC help you with the NDIS?



ILC services can help you to find information about the NDIS.



It will help you before the NDIS starts in your area.
